Package coverage
Health warnings are required to cover 75% of the front and 75% of the back of the package. Overall, 75% of the package space is appropriated to health warnings. The text of the warnings is in English on one side of the package and Malay on the other.

Rotation schedule and history
Seven warnings are used on cigarette packages.

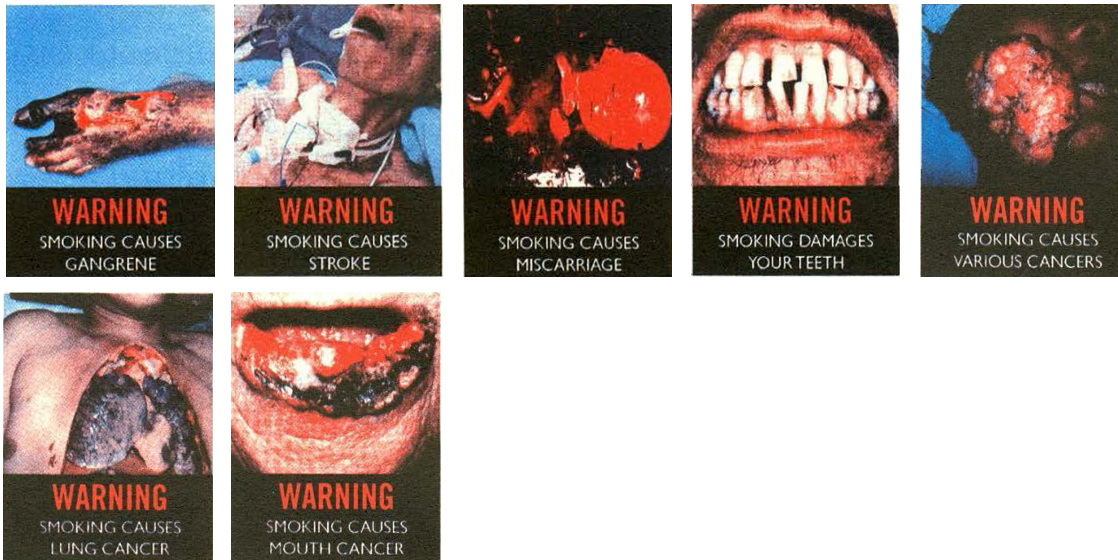
The law requires a new set of warning labels to be introduced every two years.

Restrictions on misleading information
Unspecified.

Special notes
Prior to 2012, tobacco packages were required to have health warnings covering 50% of the front and 50% of the back of the package (50% overall). In 2012, the size was increased to cover 75% of the front and 75% of the back of packages.
