



Annotated Questionnaire Nationwide Survey of Registered Voters

Would you favor or oppose the U.S. Congress passing a bill that would give the Food and Drug Administration (the FDA) the authority to regulate tobacco products, including restrictions on sales and marketing to children? (IF FAVOR/OPPOSE) And do you strongly or somewhat (favor/oppose) that?

Currently, some members of Congress are proposing adding 10 billion dollars in assistance to tobacco growers to an unrelated bill. The 10 billion dollars would be paid with taxpayer dollars and it would not include any regulation of tobacco products. Do you favor or oppose Congress passing this assistance to tobacco growers? And do you strongly or somewhat (FAVOR/OPPOSE) that?

Methodology: The nationwide telephone survey of 853 registered voters was conducted June 11-13, 2004, by Synovate's TeleNation. The margin of error is +/- 3.3 percentage points. Due to rounding, totals may not equal 100 percent.
